PROJECT NOTE

1. Background & Need

Kappattagudda Wildlife Sanctuary, located in Gadag District, is ecologically sensitive and home to rich biodiversity, including medicinal plants and endemic wildlife. With increasing **tourist inflow, vehicular movement, and human disturbances**, there is a need to establish a **check post at a prime strategic location** for effective:

- **Wildlife protection & anti-poaching control**
- **Monitoring of visitor entry/exit**
- **Prevention of illegal activities (timber, fuelwood, grazing, sand/mine transport, etc.)**
- **Strengthening ecotourism management**

2. Objective

- To establish a permanent check post for wildlife protection and visitor regulation.
- To ensure continuous monitoring of vehicular and tourist entry.
- To enhance forest security and reduce illegal activities inside the sanctuary.

3. Output (Activities & Quantity)

- Construction of Check Post Structure (1 No.)
- Room for Staff (with seating, rest shed & watch tower provision) – 1 Unit
- Signage & Display Boards – 2 Nos.
- Barrier/Gate for Vehicle Regulation – 1 No.
- Drinking water & solar lighting facility – 1 Set
- Furniture (table, chairs, register desk) – 1 Set

- Enhanced **visitor awareness and ecotourism support**.


6. Appeal for CSR Support
